Future Forward

AHMA and BC Housing sign BC Aboriginal Social Housing Management Agreement (ASHMA) – devolving all housing programs to AHMA.

AHMA strengthens self-governance. Moves to 8 Independent Directors including one appointee from BC Housing.

Informal collective of Aboriginal housing society forms, called the Urban Native Housing Societies of BC (UNSBC) UNSBC eventually evolves into what is now AHMA.
